

COMMUNICATION



Points for consideration when recommending our Education Therapy Assessment

- Detailed Analysis of Standardised Scores for Cognitive Skills
- Standardised Scores for Literacy, Maths and Phonological Awareness
- Does not produce IQ score
- Does not assess in the areas related to Social/Emotional/Behavioural/ Medical
- Can state observations related to these areas but not draw conclusions
- Can recommend consideration of Assessment by other professionals following such observations

It can be used to understand a student's learning style but most importantly, it is used as a baseline to design cognitive training and teaching programmes specific to the learner.

Subtests for the Cognitive Assessments

The Achievement tests for Literacy and Maths are chosen for their usefulness as diagnostic tools.

The assessor will be looking at whether the student...



Can segment words for reading and spelling



Can apply phonic rules



Reads and spells appropriate high frequency sight words



Chooses words in error which are similar in shape, sound or context



Recognises common letter patterns

Analysis of errors will provide information on the level of skill which the student has in the areas of Spelling, Phonics, Reading and Math computation. The type of errors will indicate the base line for the learning programme.





With a holistic approach to students' difficulties which takes full account of the history, profile and needs, your child will receive the attention he or she needs in a warm and positive environment which enables effective learning.

We understand that children learn best when they are motivated and so use a wide range of strategies including computer technology to make education fun but with the emphasis on getting maximum benefit from the opportunities available in the one to one situation.

Each of us thrives on success, so it is an essential aspect of our teaching that we identify the baseline for each student and structure the programmes specifically for the individual, something that is not often possible within larger groups.

Not all students will require standardised assessment. It depends on the student's history and needs.

Some children need extra support to help them focus and consolidate their daily learning. Others need to improve Literacy and Mathematics skills by filling in gaps in their previous learning so that they can make the most of their current and future educational opportunities.

In particular circumstances such as when the student history is indicative of Attention, Emotional, Behavioural or medical difficulties and when the report is required by MOE, the assessment can be carried out through the Dynamics Psychology Service.

Otherwise, the baseline for planning purposes will be investigated during the initial sessions of Education Therapy so that the programme can address the weaknesses and utilise the strengths of the individual.





The approach used is a multi-sensory one which aims to identify and improve areas of cognitive weakness such as auditory and visual discrimination, memory or processing speed.

Structured programmes are designed to improve reading and writing skills through language development, phonics, spelling, word attack skills, grammar, and comprehension from basic factual levels to complex inference and deduction.

We teach Math from basic concepts with emphasis on the understanding of place value and the methods for number operations with application to problem solving situations from the level of early years to secondary school.

Within the Edunamics team, we cover the Literacy and Math curriculum from preschool to leaving age within the contexts of the local school and the international systems. This

is inclusive of homeschooled students as well, both mainstream and otherwise. We can help students with a wide range of specific difficulties such as dyslexia, dyspraxia, dyscalculia, and sensory and attention disorders.

EDUCATIONAL THERAPY SERVICES FOR ADULTS

For adults who would like to improve their Cognitive Skills and fluency in Literacy, we can help!

If you have always suspected that you are Dyslexic or been diagnosed in the past but thought it was too late to do anything about it, you can also benefit from Educational Therapy. Through modern advancements in the knowledge of Plasticity of the brain and a targeted program which suits adult needs, it is quite possible to improve reading and writing skills at any age.

Cognitive profiling and Literacy programs can be designed for adults and college students as well as school age students. Education Therapists will work in a flexible way which suits the needs of the individual whether they are at college or wishing to improve reading and written skills for professional or social purposes.

For College students who require Special Exemptions and/or Additional Support, a Psychological Assessment with detailed report can give such recommendations.

For all adult learners, an Education Assessment can create a profile of Cognitive strengths and weaknesses. This profile can be used to plan programmes for the improvement of Memory skills, Fluency and Auditory/Visual Processing, which are crucial to the improvement of Literacy. However, while such a profile is very useful in identifying particular areas for improvement, it is

possible to proceed to a literacy program based on personal evidence on the areas of reading, comprehension, writing skills and vocabulary extension which are most appropriate to life and career.

All sessions are conducted on a one to one basis with an emphasis on privacy and with the goal of putting the adult learner at ease with the situation and in control of a personal plan which will address their particular needs and interests. The activities and how they relate to the individual profile will be explained and can be followed up at home in ways which will promote long term improvement in both cognitive processing and literacy.

A Senior Education Therapist at Dynamics can assist in administering the Education Assessment. Our Education Assessment is of great practical use for understanding the learning profile and highlighting why children experience problems in the learning situation. This type of assessment is of great benefit to parents, teachers, and tutors for understanding a student's learning profile, level of achievement and to provide a baseline for planning an effective Individual Education Plan or Education Therapy Programme.

Our Education Assessment can be useful for pupils who are not meeting the criteria to qualify for an assessment from within the school but not fulfilling their potential.

Our Education Assessment (SGD\$700), takes approximately 2-hours, and includes a 30-minute consultation on the student history and a 30-minutes feedback session on delivery of the report. Suitable for students from 5-years of age and above.

An in-depth analytical report is produced within 2-weeks with verbal feedback to explain the results and recommendations.

The purpose of the consultation is to gather relevant information and check if the student would be more appropriately assessed by a Psychologist.



MULTI DICIPLINARY AGENCY

In cases where the student needs to see other professionals as part of a recommended support program, the therapists at Edunamics work in liaison with our Speech Therapists, Occupational Therapists, Psychologists, and/or Physiotherapists within the clinic setting. In some cases, students are referred on to Education Therapy by our other departments as progress is achieved, needs change, or assessment indicates. Depending on the student's individual progress and needs, some may see different professionals concurrently.

Programs offered under Dynamics Kids Therapy Centre will be accessible to students under Edunamics should they require such services. A sample of the many programs available are as follows:



SOCIAL SKILLS GROUPS

For a variety of age groups (incl. 4-6 years, 6-8 years). Run by our multi-disciplinary departments, incl. speech/occupational therapists/psychologists. Groups are formed based on language levels and needs.



PHONICS GROUPS

For children 4-7 years who have basic verbal skills but need additional support to improve reading and writing. Involves songs and games to teach foundations of phonics.



HANDWRITING GROUP (PREP)

For children 4-6 years old (Pre-School) to help with pre-writing skills and some letter formation.



Play & Write

HANDWRITING GROUP (FUN)

For children 6-8 years (Primary) with a focus on handwriting skills, words and sentences.



HANDWRITING GROUP (ADVANCE)

for children 8-10 years old to help develop advanced writing skills and creative writing
